

RootMax diploid annual ryegrass is the result of a polycross between Marshall, Ribeye, and TAM90 annual ryegrasses. RootMax combines the quick establishment and forage yield of Ribeye, the crown rust resistance of TAM90 and the frost tolerance and consistent yield of Marshall. Tested throughout the South, RootMax annual ryegrass is proving to be a real contender among new forage annual ryegrasses. RootMax exhibits high forage yield, excellent seedling vigor, and medium maturity, allowing consistency in forage yield throughout the season with good transition back into warm-season forage grasses.
